**Abita Springs Golf & Country Club**

golf experience, with water on 10 holes, fairway bunkers on eight holes, greenside bunkers on 10 holes and greens that were freshly renovated in the summer of 2009.

Affordable golf and open to the public with a rustic log cabin clubhouse/bar that offers a setting like the sitcom *Cheers*—"Where everybody knows your name"!

**The Bluffs Country Club**

(225) 634-6400, [www.thebluffs.com](http://www.thebluffs.com). An Arnold Palmer signature golf course nestled among the hardwoods and lush landscape of West Feliciana Parish. Located in the wilderness of Thompson Creek that was revered by the painter of *Birds of America*, John James Audubon, the layout traverses a dense forest and white sand creek shore, with shots over hills, off bluffs and into hollows. Some elevation changes are as much as 50 feet, including the spectacular par-3 17th. Open to public play.

**Carter Plantation**

Carter Plantation is home to PGA champion and Louisiana native David Toms' first signature design and the course was a recipient of *Golf Magazine's* "Top 10 Courses You Can Play." The spectacular par-72 golf course winds through three distinct Louisiana landscapes—live oak flats, cypress wetlands and upland pine forests.
